Granular Application to Turf

During the week of April 6, 2026, Verdego will be applying granular turf applications to your lawn. This treatment is designed to strengthen the grass, improve overall health, and support consistent growth throughout the season.

Irrigation Update

In accordance with recommendations from the St. Johns River Water Management District irrigation runs two times per week.

As we approach the warmer months and enter the dry season, please note that irrigation systems are intended to help sustain turf and plant life during periods of heat—they are not a substitute for natural rainfall or the nutrients it provides.

Natural rainwater delivers essential nutrients such as nitrogen to the soil, promotes deeper root growth, and allows for more even and effective absorption into the ground compared to irrigation systems. It also helps flush out salts and buildup that can accumulate from treated water sources, improving overall soil health and plant vitality. With this irrigation frequency, homeowners will be responsible for providing any additional supplemental watering necessary to maintain the health and appearance of their lawns and landscaping.
